### Voter Registration Deadline

The deadline for voter registration at the circuit clerk's office is **Saturday, October 3 at 12:00 p.m.** Mail-in voter registration applications must be postmarked no later than October 3, 2015. ### General Election is Fast Approaching – Tuesday, November 3

Polls in Mississippi will be open **Tuesday, November 3**, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. If a runoff election is necessary, that election will be held three weeks later on November 24, 2015. Polls will again be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

### Absentee Voting Deadline

Absentee ballots for the November 2015 election are available at the local circuit clerk's office. The deadline for in-person absentee voting is **Saturday, October 31 at 12:00 p.m.** Any absentee ballots mailed must be **RECEIVED** by the circuit clerk's office by **Monday, November 2 at 5:00 p.m.**
